

# Rotary Ride for Hearing

## Corporate Team Challenge

July 14, 2024

**“A great ride with friends to raise money for the deaf and hard of hearing in British Columbia!”**

### The Corporate Team Challenge Requirements:

1. Any organization forms a corporate team (or more than one team) consisting of between 4 and 9 members per team and
  - (a) Challenges its customers, suppliers, competitors, and perhaps co-workers.
  - (b) Competes for –
    - (i) bragging rights; and
    - (ii) the Corporate Challenge Cup trophy awarded to the low net team time (after fundraising time bonuses detailed below under the heading “Criteria for a Corporate Team”).
2. To create a team and add members, please register your team online by going to <https://rotaryvancouver.org/ride-for-hearing> and clicking Register Now.
  - (a) The Team Captain must register first and name the Team. Additional Team members can then register under that Team name.
  - (b) No later than 48 hours before the 2024 Rotary Ride for Hearing (i. e. by noon on Friday, July 12) since for the Ride which will be held on July 14, 2024, the identity of team members must be fixed; i.e. the Team Captain and up to eight (8) additional individuals making up

the Team. After 12:00 noon on July 12, no further additions will be allowed, so think ahead and plan for spares in case of injury or other reasons for a rider having to withdraw from riding.

(b) Each team member will be expected to have raised at least \$500 before the ride if his or her results are to be counted.

3. All Corporate Team members are entitled to the full rider benefit package as detailed on the Rotary Ride for Hearing website, <https://rotaryvancouver.org/ride-for-hearing>, including:

(a) Food and beverages at all checkpoints;

(b) Fruit, energy bars and non-alcoholic drinks at the Finish Line;

(c) Subject to:

- raising at least \$500 in donations for Rotary Club of Vancouver Hearing Foundation as part of its 2024 Rotary Ride for Hearing; and
- subject to availability and a request made by June 14, 2024;

priority access for up to two adults at the End of Ride Finish Line Awards Celebration which will officially begin at 12:00 noon on July 14, 2024;

(d) secured bike storage, if required, at the finish line while enjoying post ride festivities.

### Criteria for a Corporate Team:

1. A Corporate Team consists of at least four members and no more than 9, of any gender.
2. Each team member must have raised at least \$500 for the Rotary Club of Vancouver Hearing Foundation's current Rotary Ride for Hearing before the ride starts, or their time will not be included in determining the four fastest riders on that team, or the average of the four fastest times for that team;

3. **A teams' finishing time (the "Team Time") is the chip time of the fourth fastest eligible rider on that team who crosses the finish line. Only "Chip Time" is relevant, and the actual order of crossing the finish line is not relevant;**
4. **An eligible rider is a team member who has registered for the ride and who has raised at least \$500 by the start of the Ride;**
5. **If more than 9 riders are designated, then unless a Rotary Ride for Hearing Committee Chair (Franz Gehriger or Phil Webber) agrees to the deletion of named team members before the Ride to reduce the number to a maximum of nine riders, the team will not be eligible to win the Corporate Challenge Cup. Please note that a corporation, not-for-profit or other entity, including a Rotary or other Club, can enter more than one corporate team in the Corporate Challenge Cup competition, but the maximum number of members on each team is 9. Members of the corporate Challenge Cup teams for a single entity can also be named as one team for purposes of the Ed Fisk Memorial Team Cup fundraising competition.**
6. **An "elementary" finish time bonus (reduction to the Team Time) of 15 minutes applies to those teams raising at least \$1000 per rider.**
7. **A "celebratory" finish time bonus (reduction to the Team Time) of 30 minutes applies to those teams raising at least \$1500 per rider**
8. **An ultimate finish time bonus (reduction to the Team Time) of 45 minutes applies to those teams raising at least \$2000 per rider.**
9. **Some tips for administering your Team:**
  - **Be sure to include all team members as cc's on your emails and other communications so each member of your team is aware of the Team's requirements and the requirements of Rotary Ride for Hearing as regards your and other Teams;**
  - **Ensure all individuals on your Team understand their obligation to raise at least \$500 for the Rotary Club of Vancouver Hearing Foundation and its campaign to:**

**"Bring Back the Sounds of Life!"**
